 - a. Jews read but misunderstood. (Acts 13:27).
 - b. Jews sometimes needed help in understanding. (Neh. 8:6-8; Acts 8)

III. Works.

- A. Base meaning: Things one does and results of what he does.
- B. Bible applications:
 - 1. Merit or accomplishment. (Eph. 2:8,9)
 - 2. System of works or law of works. (Rom. 3,4)
 - 3. Acts of obedience the faith. (Jas. 2)

IV. Church.

- A. Base meaning: An assemble called out for a purpose.
- B. Accommodative meanings: Building
- C. Bible Applications:
 - 1. Israel in the wilderness. (Acts 7:38)
 - 2. Secular Assembly. (Acts 19)
 - 3. Universal (Eph. 4:4)
 - 4. Local
 - a. Organization. (1 Cor. 1:1).
 - b. Meeting. (1 Cor. 11,14)
