# The Fallout from the Fall of Man Gen 3:1-24

#### Introduction:

- A. The story of Adam and Eve undercuts some very popular theories:
  - 1. The theory of evolution.
  - 2. The theory that *one* sin does not hurt.
  - 3. The theory that "my sin is nobody's business but mine."
- B. The fall of Adam and Eve has had some tremendous *repercussions* for all of humanity.

#### Discussion:

## I. It Has Resulted in *Death* for All People.

- A. Physical death has come upon all men unconditionally.
  - 1. Adam and Eve's sin and death sentence. (vv. 1-6; 22-24)
  - 2. Death sentence passed on. ("And he died" [Gen. 5]; 1 Cor. 15:22; Heb. 9:27)
- B. Spiritual death has come upon all men conditionally.
  - 1. Sin kills one spiritually by separating him from God (Rom. 7:11; Isa. 59:1,2; cf. Eph. 2:1,5).
  - 2. Adam introduced sin, but each dies spiritually for own sins. (Rom. 5:12; 7:7-12; Ezek. 18:20)

## II. It Has Resulted in *Profound Effects on Day to Day Living* for All People.

- A. Effects on the quality of life.
  - 1. Curse was not childbearing nor work, but made them harder (1:28; 2:15; 3:16-19).
  - 2. Physical evil caused by Satan & sin God allows it for our good. (Cf. 2 Cor. 12:7; Job)
- B. Effects on the style of life.
  - 1. Sense of shame and need for covering nakedness (v. 7-12, 21; cf. Rev. 3:18).
  - 2. Man over the woman (v. 16; cf. 1 Tim. 2:12-15; 1 Cor. 11:3; Eph. 5:23)

## It Has Resulted in the Need for the Redemption of All People.

- A. Scheme of redemption is announced.
  - 1. The Seed of the woman (v. 15; cf. Gal. 4:4; Isa. 7:14)
  - 2. According to eternal purpose of God. (Eph. 3:8-11).
- B. Scheme of redemption is implemented in history.
  - 1. Events of Old Testament: Call of Abraham; Forming nation; giving Law; preserving Nation.
  - 2. Christ came in fulness of time. (Gal. 4:4).
