- A. Galatians wanted another plan of salvation
 - 1. Wanted same man (Christ) but different plan (law) (cf. Gal 1:6; 6:12; Acts 15:1)
 - 2. Wanted new plan to them but old to Paul. (1:13,14; 2:18,19)
 - 3. Began to pratice it to a degree. (4:10).
 - 4. Wanted to avoid opposition of Jews. (6:12)
 - 5. May have thought the could some merge two plans. (5:1-4).
- B. Galatians told that the two plans would not mix! had irreconcilable differences:

I. The Difference Between A National Law and A Universal Promise.

- A. Promise of Abraham extended to all nations (3:1-9)
- B. Law of Moses given to one nation. (cf. Deut. 5:1-6,15; Rom. 3:1-2)
- C. God's inheritance given through Christ and gospel not Israel and law.

II. The Difference Between Life and Death. (3:10-14)

- A. To live by the law one had to do it. (v. 10, 12) no one did it
- B. To live by faith is to live by forgiveness of Christ.

III. The Difference Between Seed and Seeds (3:16)

- A. A promised selected and singular seed Christ
- B. Rather than many seeds Jews.

IV. The Difference Between Childhood and Adulthood.

- A. Minor child was as a servant. (4:1-2; 3:19-4:7).
- B. Major child had inheritance with all rights of sonship. (cf. Lk. 15:12).

V. The Difference in Bondage and Freedom.

- A. From one bondange to another (4:8-10).
- B. From Sarah to Hagar (4:21-5:1).

VI. The Difference Between Whole Law And Whole Gospel.

- A. Consistency demands keep whole of either if subject to them.(5:2-4).
- B. Law had to be changed for Christ to be priest. (Heb. 7).

VII. The Difference Between Spirit and Flesh (5:16-18).
