#### Introduction:

- A. Daniel to Babylon in 606 B.C.
  - 1. With Shadrach, Meshach, Abed-Nego became servants in the kings court.
  - 2. Nebuchadnezzar's dream. (vv. 31-35).
  - 3. Foretold the kingdom of God.
- B. Let's study some aspects of that kingdom.

## I. The *Time* of the Kingdom of God.

- A. To be set up during Roman Empire.
  - 1. Daniel. (vv. 37-44)
    - a. Head of Gold was Nebuchadnezzar's kingdom. (v. 38 606-536).
    - b. Chest and Arms of Silver was Medo-Persian Kingdom. (536-332)
    - c. Belly and Thighs of Bronze was kingdom of Alexander the Great. (331-146)
    - d. Legs of iron and feet of iron and clay was Roman Empire. (146-A.D. 400)
  - 2. John the Baptist. (Matt. 3:1-2)
  - 3. Jesus (Matt. 4:17; Mark 9:1; John 18:37)
  - 4. Paul and John (Col. 1:13; Rev. 1:9)
- B. To be delivered up at second coming. (1 Cor. 15:23-28).

## II. The Nature of the kingdom of God.

- A. Stronger and longer other kingdoms. (vv. 34, 35, 44).
  - 1. Kingdoms of text are long gone kingdom still here.
  - 2. Kingdom of God never destroyed seed (word) never destroyed.
- B. Different from other kingdoms. (John 18:36).
  - 1. Operates in a different realm not political. (Cf. Matt. 22:21)
  - 2. Expanded and defended with different means not "by the sword."
  - 3. Spiritual rather than physical (Luke 17:20-21)

## III. The *Identity* of the Kingdom of God.

- A. "Kingdom" and "church" interchangeable (Matt. 16:18, 19).
- B. Jesus raised to throne raised to be head of church. (Acts 2:30-36: Eph 1:20-22).
- C. Saved ones added to church Translated into kingdom (Acts 2:38, 41, 47; Col. 1:12-14)
- D. Jesus has power and dominion beyond the church. (Matt. 28:18; Eph. 1:20, 21; cf. Dan 4:25).

## IV. The Importance of the kingdom of God.

- A. It must be put first. (Matt. 6:33).
- B. It's citizens greater than John the Baptist. (Matt. 11:9-11).
- C. It is like a treasure. (Matt. 13:44).
- D. It is place of Lord's Table or Lord's supper. (Matt. 26:29; Luke 22:29,30).
