The Shutting up of the Kingdom

Matt. 23:13

Introduction:

- A. Two families find Opryland shut at end of long journey.
- B. Likewise, many Jews had kingdom door shut by religious leaders.
 - 1. Some intimidated by their power.
 - 2. Others turned of by their brand of religion.
 - 3. Jesus and John opening, Pharisees shutting.
- C. Professed Christians' brand of religion shuts up kingdom to many.
- D. Things of the Pharisees that tended to turn many off:

Discussion:

I. Their Mere Lip Service (vv. 1-3; Matt. 15:9)

- A. Must transcend mere words (Matt. 7:21; 1 John 3:18)
- B. People watch what we do more than what we say.

II. Their Lack of Self-application (v. 4).

- A. This caused God's name to be blasphemed (Rom. 2:21-24).
- B. This will turn people off to our message.
 - 1. Our children
 - 2. Our friends.

III. Their Public Relations Religion (vv. 5-12; 25-28).

- A. Outward/public display differed from inward/private reality.
- B. When people see past the front they are turned off.

IV. Their Hair-splitting Loopholes (vv. 16-22; Matt. 15:5).

- A. Religious people devise loopholes.
 - 1. Mark 16:16 doesn't say "he that is baptized not..."
 - 2. Acts 20:7 doesn't say "every" first day.
 - 3. Bible doesn't say must attend EVERY service.
- B. Such loophole hunting gives religion a bad name.

V. Their Selective Obedience (v. 23-24)

- A. Lord did not fault them from strictness but inconsistency.
- B. Partial obedience is really no obedience (Jas. 2:10; King Saul)

Conclusion:

- A. Many would not enter the kingdom, no matter what.
- B. Make no mistake about it, such adverse influence shuts many out of the kingdom.
